- Coahuila, Mexico

**Reforestamos** has initiated a remarkable transformation within Mexico's candelilla wax-producing communities through their project, 'Developing a Strategy to Boost Production of Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Certified Candelilla.'

This initiative addresses the pressing issues of low wages and unsustainable working conditions. Their sustainable production project, guided by meticulous regional analysis, empowers communities to adopt eco-friendly practices, obtain crucial permits, and scale up production. Through informative workshops, they've cultivated local awareness about forest permits and responsible management, propelling these regions toward self-sufficiency.

By prioritizing worker well-being and community acceptance, Reforestamos is shaping a brighter, more environmentally conscious future for candelilleros and their communities.

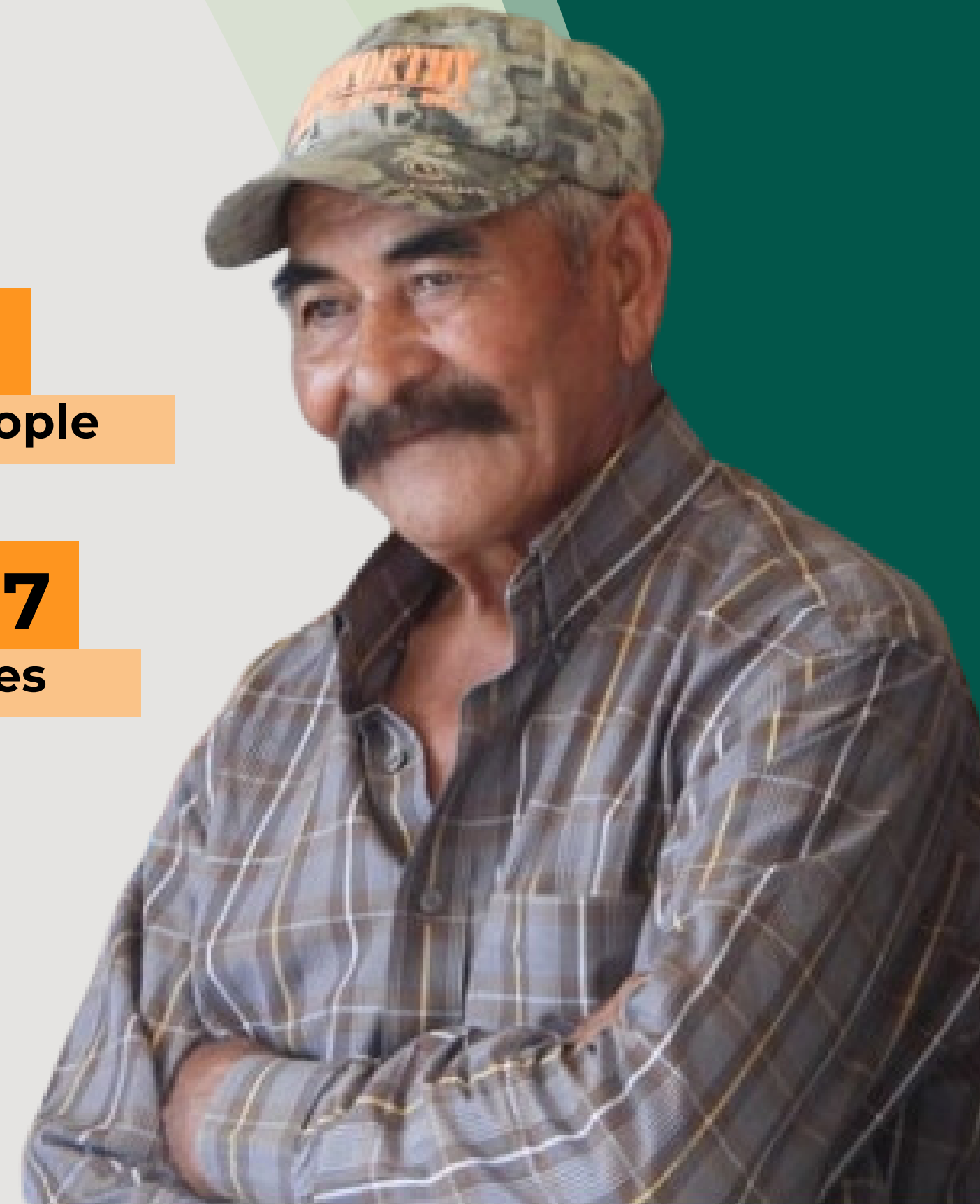

# Dominica National Council of Women

-Roseau, Commonwealth of Dominica

The **Dominica National Council of Women (DNCW)** serves as an umbrella organization for all **56 of the island's women's groups**. The DNCW crisis program provides both prevention and response support, while the Council's development programs place emphasis on women in rural areas.

The 2022 project sought to rehabilitate women farmers and their holdings following the impact of natural disasters that worsened COVID-19 consequences. Recognizing the limited access to alternative employment and forms of livelihood, the project's workshops aimed to embolden women in rural areas by helping them increase their productive capacity and take on community leadership roles.

Founded in 1999 to assist underprivileged children, **ABID** focuses on providing institutional shelter (institutional care) for children in situations of psychosocial risk. Working to build stronger family ties while addressing and preventing situations of trauma and abandonment, ABID aspires to guarantee children's rights in family and community living situations.

In the last year, ABID provided additional psychological and emotional support to 102 children, as well as served 683 family members under a post-displacement monitoring process that empowers familial bonds and awareness of children's rights.

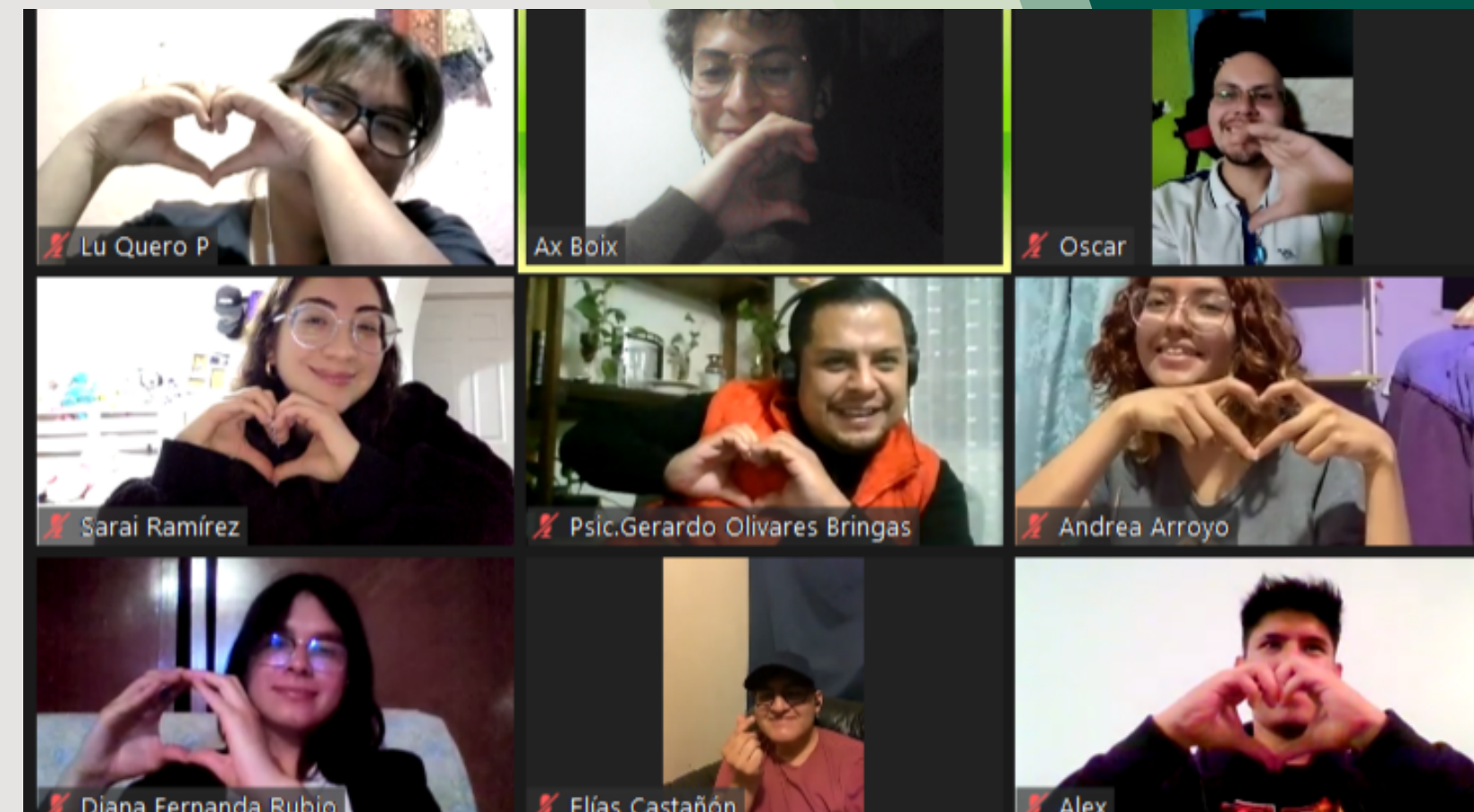
